





## INTRODUCTION

Established in **1982**, the **Dr. Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation**, Ahilyanagar, stands as a testament to the visionary leadership of **Hon’ble Dr. Eknathrao alias Balasaheb Vikhe Patil**, a pioneer of cooperative development and rural education in India. Driven by his unwavering belief that quality education and healthcare must reach rural and marginalized communities, the Foundation was conceived as a catalyst for social and economic transformation. Guided by this noble mission, it has evolved into a multidisciplinary institution encompassing premier establishments in medicine, nursing, physiotherapy, pharmacy, agriculture, engineering, and management. At its core stands the flagship **Dr. Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation’s Medical College and Hospital**, reflecting the enduring philosophy that “*Service to Humanity is Service to God*”.

The Foundation continues to flourish under the progressive leadership of **Hon’ble Dr. Radhakrishna Vikhe Patil**, who carries forward the legacy of rural upliftment and social reform envisioned by his father. This vision is further strengthened by **Hon’ble Dr. Sujay Radhakrishna Vikhe Patil**, whose forward-looking and innovative approach has steered the institution toward global standards in medical education and healthcare delivery.

The Medical College was established in **2004**, marking a significant milestone in the Foundation’s journey toward comprehensive community development. Beginning with an intake of **100 MBBS students**, the college rapidly earned recognition for its academic rigour, ethical medical training, and disciplined learning environment. In response to the growing demand for skilled medical professionals, the MBBS intake was enhanced to **150 seats in 2012** and further expanded to **200 seats in 2021**, following full compliance with statutory norms of the **National Medical Commission**. The institution is affiliated with the **Maharashtra University of Health Sciences**, Nashik, and follows **Competency-Based Medical Education (CBME)**, ensuring skill-oriented, patient-centric, and community-responsive learning.

Postgraduate medical education was introduced in **2011** with **29 seats across 10 disciplines** and has steadily expanded in line with the institution’s academic growth. Through sustained development of infrastructure, faculty strength, and clinical exposure, postgraduate intake has

increased to **76 seats by 2024**, spanning a wide range of specialities. The institution also offers **PhD programs** in Anatomy, Forensic Medicine, Biochemistry, Pathology, and Paediatrics, along with specialised fellowships and certificate programs, including the Neonatology Fellowship, Mid-Level Service Provider Course, and Certificate Course in Modern Pharmacology, reflecting its commitment to advanced medical education and research.

The college's dedication to academic excellence has earned recognition at both national and state levels. In **2022**, it achieved **A+ accreditation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council**, becoming the first medical college under MUHS to secure an A+ Grade in its first cycle under the new Health Sciences Manual. In **2023**, the institution was honoured with the **Best Medical College Award** by MUHS, reaffirming its position among the leading medical colleges in Maharashtra.

Academic leadership under **Dr. Sunil Natha Mhaske**, Dean of the College and a distinguished Paediatrician, has been instrumental in advancing academic reforms, mentoring students, and strengthening institutional governance. His receipt of the **MUHS Best Teacher Award in 2017**, along with the **Best of Best Teacher Award** conferred on **Dr. Sharadini Dahanukar**, reflects the institution's strong culture of teaching excellence. Further adding to its accolades, the college was conferred the **Eat Right Campus – 5 Star Plus Rating** by the **Ministry of Health and Family Welfare**, underscoring its commitment to nutrition, hygiene, and sustainability.

## THE CAMPUS

Dr. Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation's Medical College and Hospital, Ahilyanagar, is a meticulously planned campus developed in strict accordance with National Medical Commission (NMC) norms, fostering excellence in medical education, clinical training, research, and community healthcare services. Sprawling across 33 acres with a built-up area of 128,632 square meters, the campus is nestled amidst the picturesque hills of the Ghats of Vilad in the rural expanse of Ahilyanagar district. The architectural layout reflects a student-centric, technology-enabled, and environmentally sustainable academic ecosystem. Surrounded by lush greenery and pollution-free breezes, the tranquil environment provides an ideal setting for academic pursuits as well as the restful recovery of patients. Additionally, the campus is comprehensively equipped to meet the daily needs of students, faculty, staff, and visitors, ensuring comfort, convenience, and a supportive learning and healing atmosphere.

### College Buildings:

**Block I – Administrative and Academic Wing** houses the Dean's Office, administrative departments, lecture halls, para-clinical departments, central research facilities, and student support services. The administrative setup includes the Establishment Section, Student Section, HR Office, Accounts, Purchase and Store Sections, Electrical, Civil, Legal, and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), ensuring smooth academic governance and regulatory compliance.



The college has **four major air-conditioned lecture halls** with advanced audiovisual facilities:

- Dhanvantari Hall – 250 seats



- Charak Hall – 240 seats



- Sushrut Hall – 240 seats



- Padmashree Hall – 250 seats



Additionally, the **Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam Auditorium** with a seating capacity of **1200** serves as the central venue for conferences, CME programs, examinations, and institutional events.

**Para-clinical departments** in Block I include Pathology, Microbiology, Pharmacology, and Community Medicine, each equipped with well-developed laboratories, museums, demonstration rooms, departmental libraries, and faculty cabins.

The **Central Library**, spanning over **2,400 sq. meters**, functions as the academic knowledge hub with seating for **480 users**. It houses more than **14,000 medical textbooks and reference books**, national and international journals, digital databases, and NMC-mandated e-resources. The library is fully automated, Wi-Fi enabled, CCTV monitored, and supported by reading rooms operating **24×7**.



### Central Library

A state-of-the-art **Skill Laboratory** covering approximately **800 sq. meters** plays a pivotal role in implementing **Competency-Based Medical Education (CBME)**. It includes basic and advanced skill stations, simulation manikins, trauma and airway management models, audiovisual learning zones, and structured training schedules for undergraduate students, interns, and postgraduate trainees.



### Skill Laboratory Demonstration

**Block II – Basic Sciences Wing** accommodates the foundational departments of Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Forensic Medicine & Toxicology, and Community Medicine. Each department is provided with dissection halls, laboratories, museums, demonstration rooms, and modern teaching-learning facilities, strengthening the academic foundation of medical students.

## Hospital Infrastructure and Clinical Training Facilities



The teaching hospital forms an integral part of the medical college campus with a **total built-up area of 55,432.01 sq. meters** and functions as a **tertiary care hospital with more than 800 teaching beds**. It provides comprehensive clinical exposure through well-organized **OPD, IPD, ICU, OT complex, Emergency (Casualty), and Super-Specialty services**.

The hospital includes departments of Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Paediatrics, Orthopaedics, Ophthalmology, ENT, Dermatology, Psychiatry, Dentistry, and super-specialties such as Cardiology, Neurology, Nephrology, Oncology, Urology, Gastroenterology, and Plastic Surgery. Diagnostic services include **Radiology, MRI, CT, PET-CT, Blood Bank, Central Clinical Laboratory**, and pharmacy services.

### **Hostel Facilities for Medical Students**

The **Dr. Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation's Medical College and Hospital** places strong emphasis on providing a safe, disciplined, and supportive residential environment for its undergraduate and postgraduate students. The institution offers well-planned hostel facilities within the secure and serene campus, ensuring a *home-away-from-home* atmosphere that supports academic focus, personal growth, and overall well-being.

Students from diverse cultural, linguistic, and regional backgrounds reside together in an environment that fosters mutual respect, harmony, and holistic development. The hostels are

managed by the **Hostel Section**, which functions as the central administrative unit responsible for the smooth operation of all hostel facilities, including student welfare, maintenance of amenities, mess services, cleanliness, and discipline. All hostel operations strictly adhere to institutional policies and applicable government norms, ensuring the safety, comfort, and well-being of residents.

Each hostel is equipped with modern infrastructure and essential amenities designed to meet the daily needs of students. Facilities include **fully furnished rooms with cots, tables, and cupboards, hot water supply, and RO-enabled drinking water coolers**. Clean and well-maintained toilets and bathrooms are provided, along with **high-speed Wi-Fi connectivity** to support academic activities.



### **Newly inaugurated Sindhu Hostel for Girls**

Common facilities such as **TV rooms, recreation and indoor games rooms**, and designated study-friendly spaces encourage relaxation and peer interaction. **24×7 security** is ensured through trained personnel, **CCTV surveillance in corridors and common areas**, and a **biometric in–out attendance system**, maintaining a safe and disciplined residential environment.

Each hostel is supervised by a **dedicated Warden and Rector**, supported by **Anti-Ragging Squads, Hostel Advisory Committees, and Hostel Committees**, ensuring continuous monitoring, grievance redressal, and student support. Additional services such as **laundry facilities and parking for authorized vehicles** enhance resident convenience.

Clear hostel policies are in place, including **strict regulations on late-night entry and prohibition of outside stay**, to maintain discipline and ensure student safety. Through these

comprehensive facilities and governance mechanisms, the institution ensures a secure, comfortable, and conducive living environment that complements the academic mission of the Medical College.


**B. Curriculum – Syllabus and Co-Curricular Aspects**








**B. Curriculum – Syllabus and Co-Curricular Aspects**
