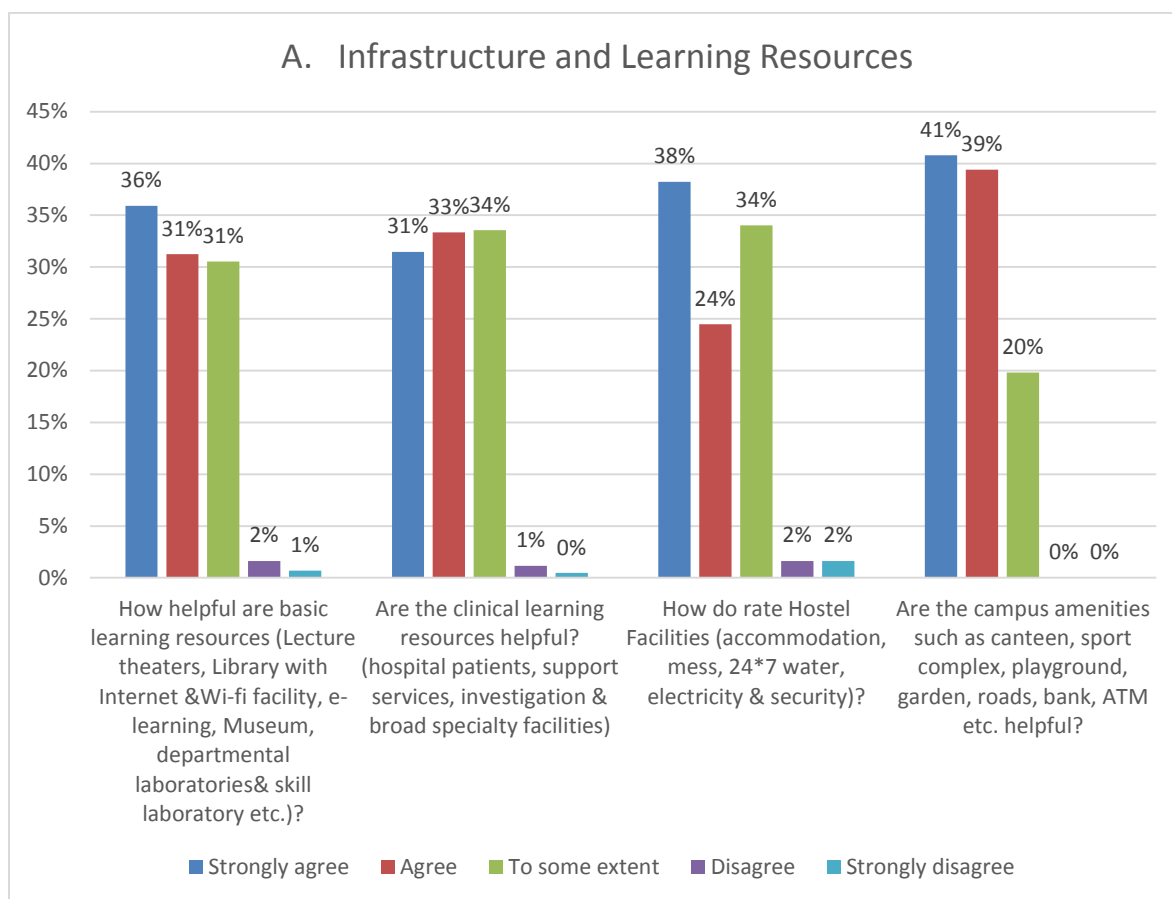

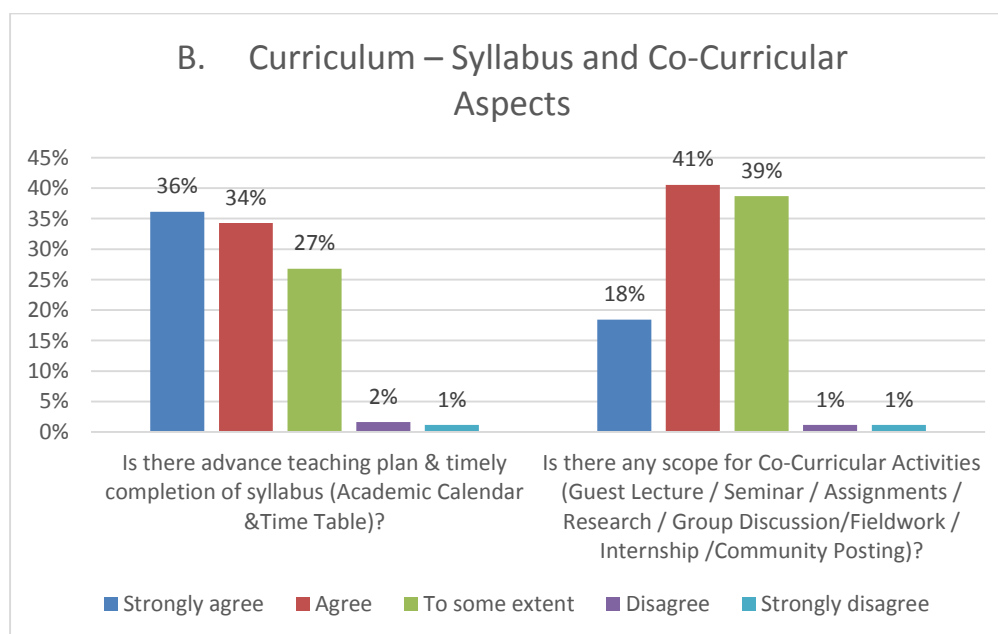

- Please review and improve the canteen facilities, including an upgrade to the menu and overall amenities

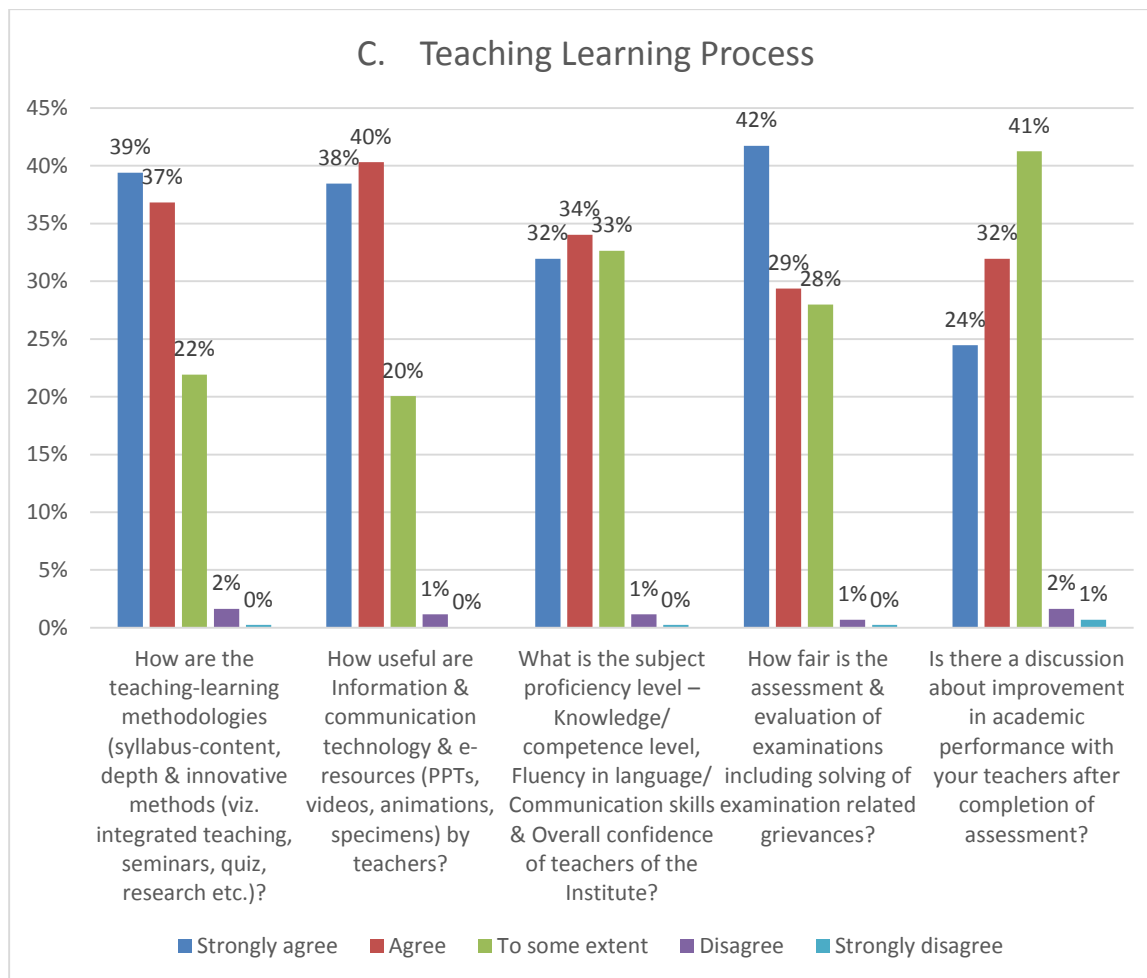
