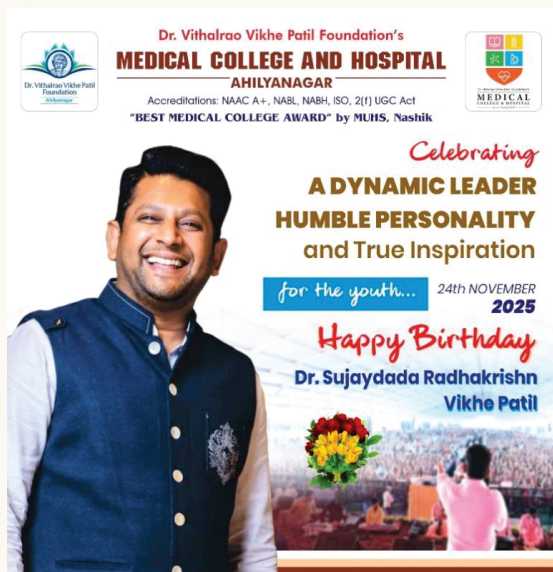
Title of Activity : Celebration of Hon'ble CEO Dr. Sujay Radhakrishna Vikhe Patil Sir Birthday.

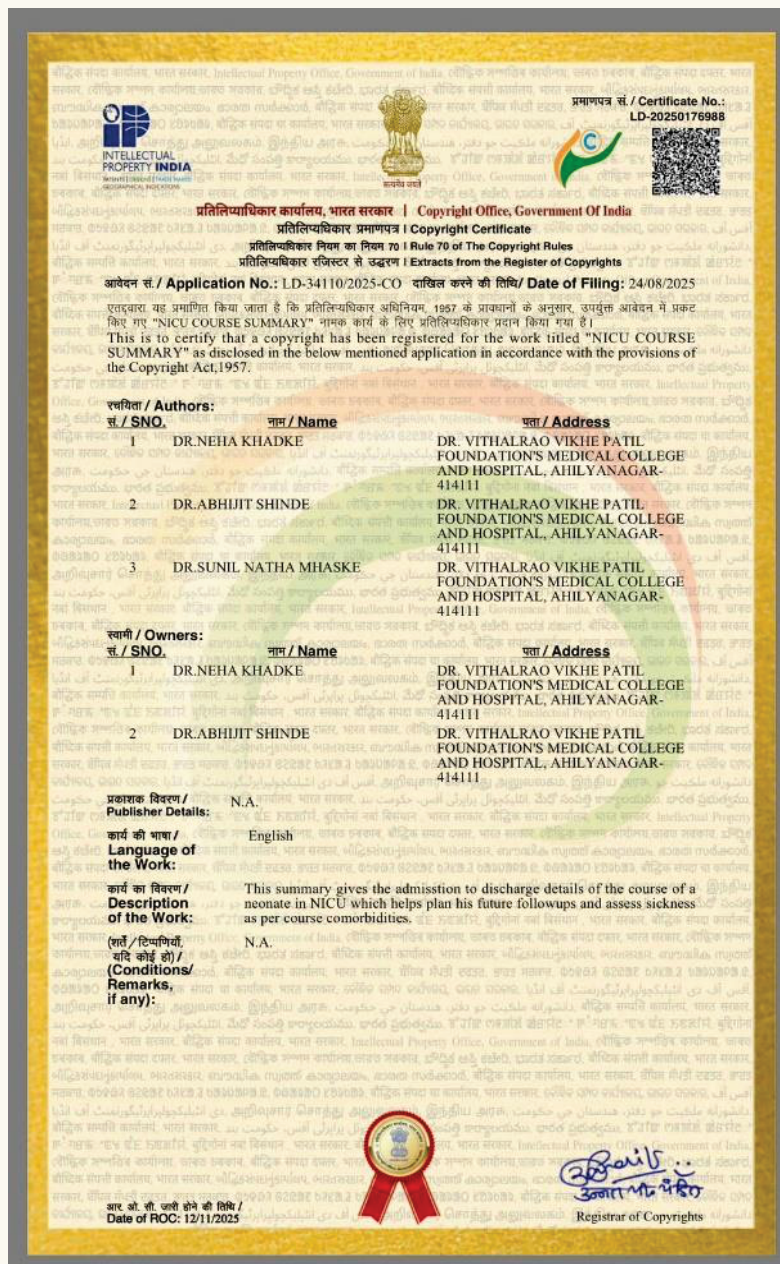
