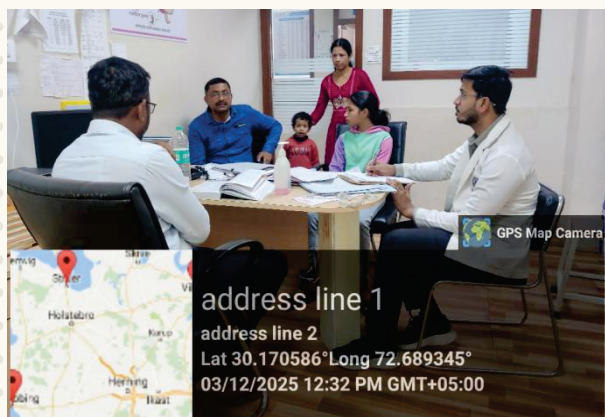
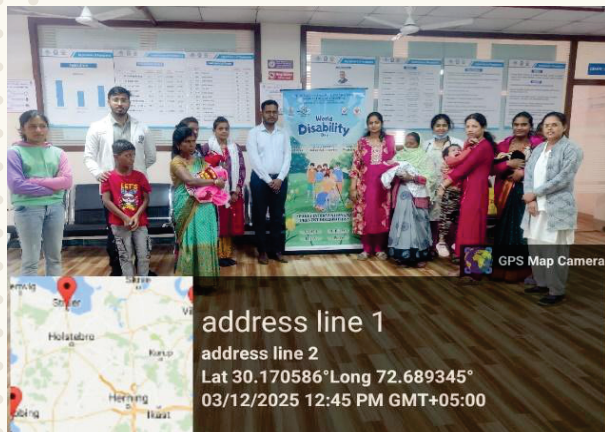


EVENT - 4


EVENT - 5

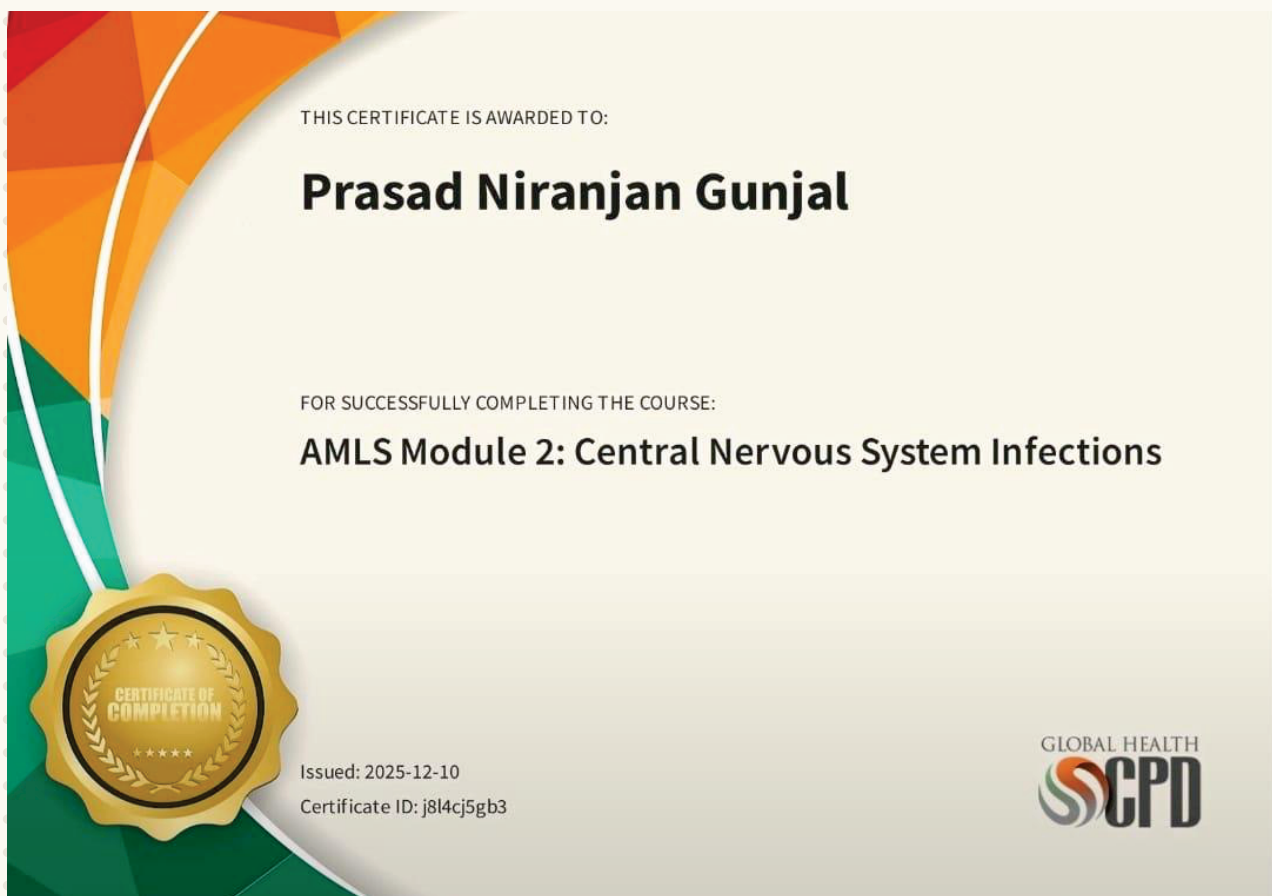

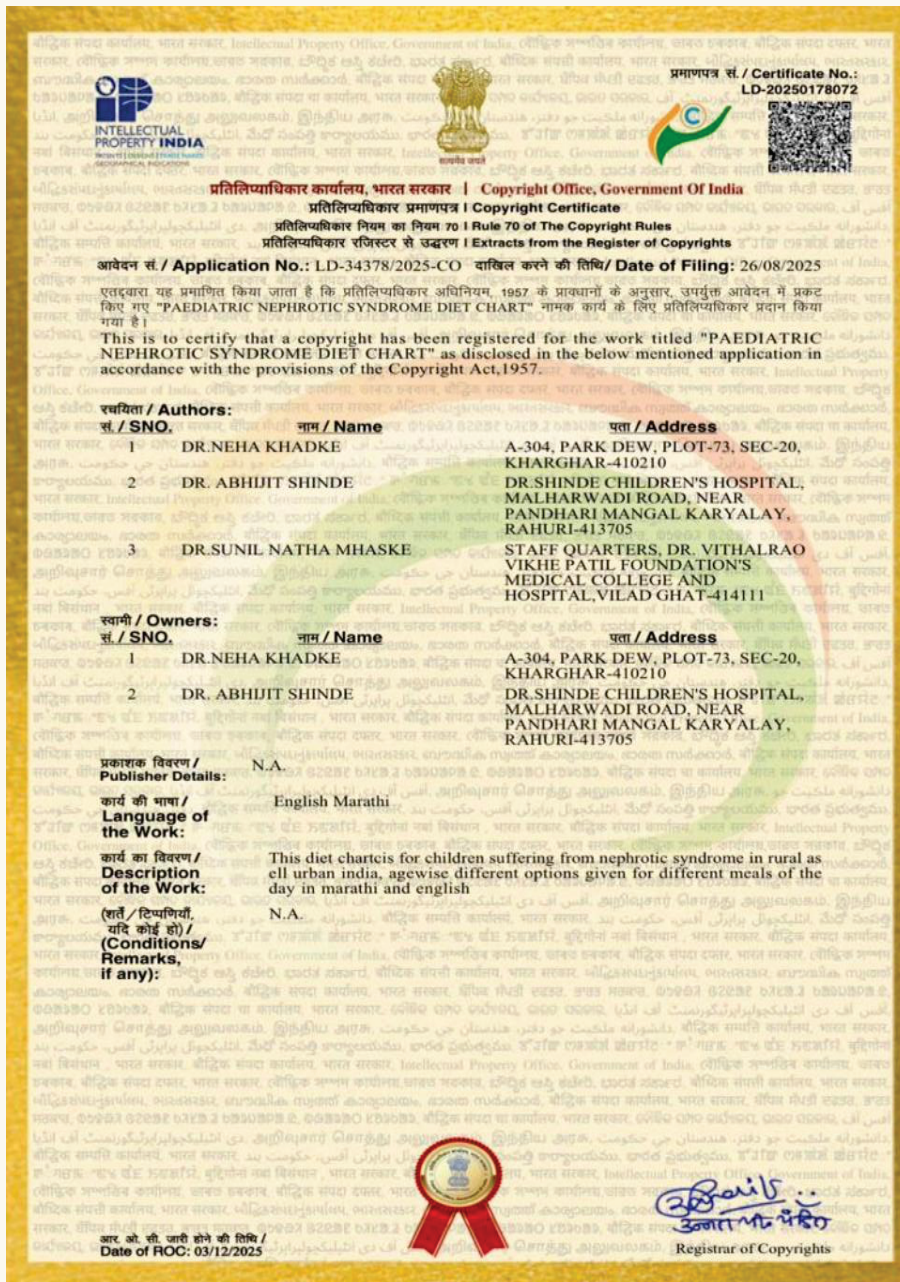

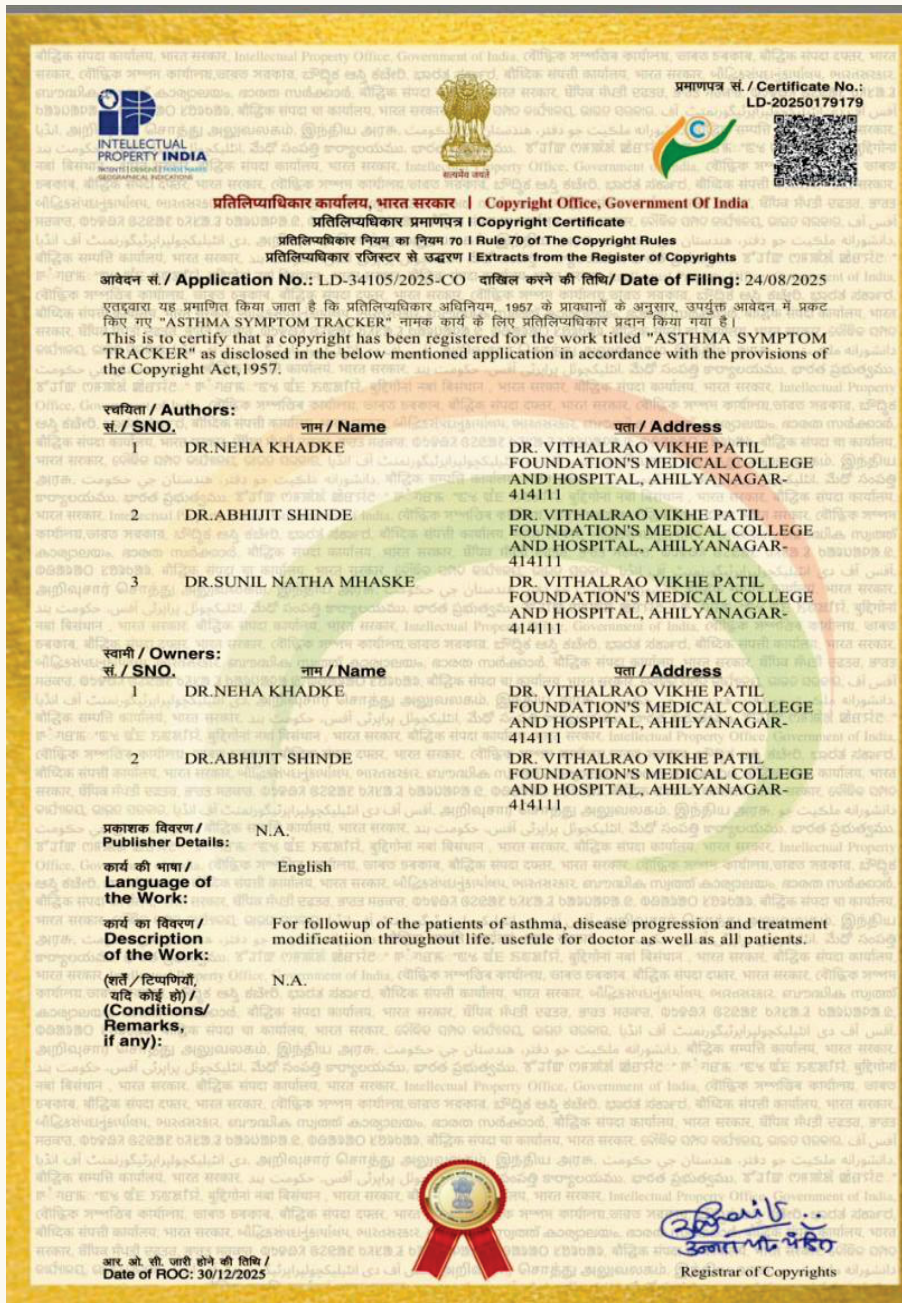
