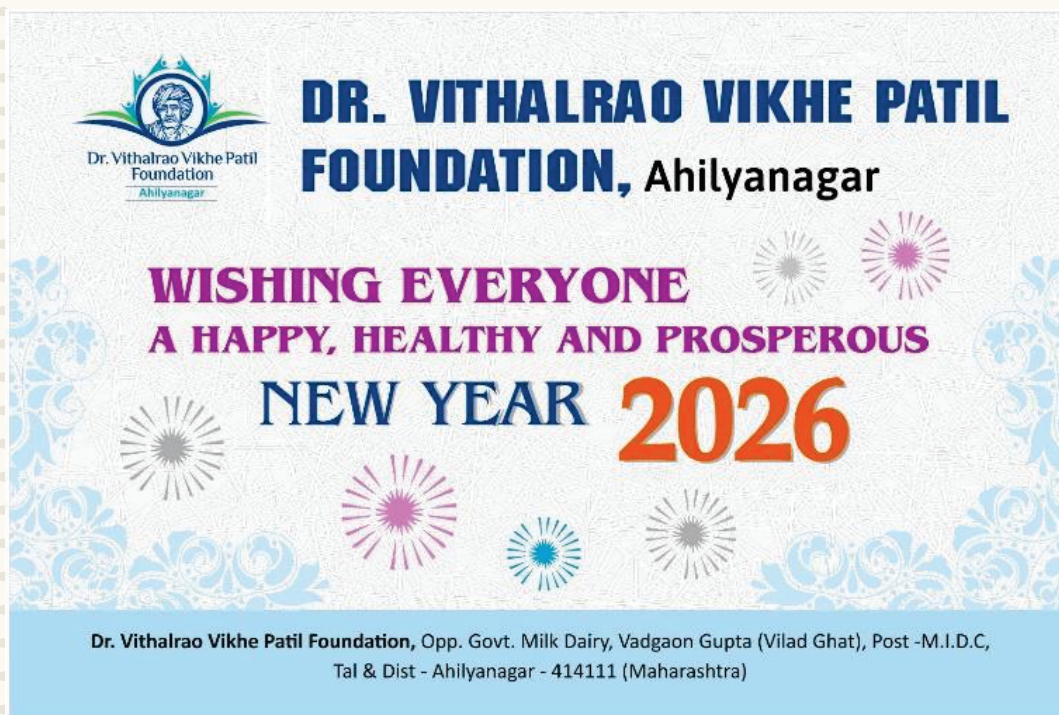

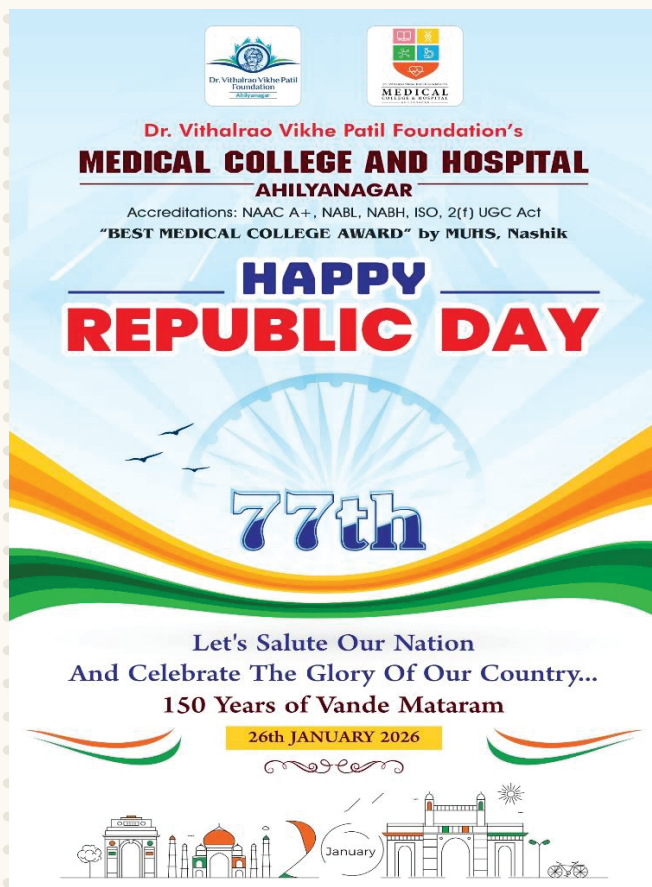

The event contributed to enhancing knowledge and sensitisation among future healthcare professionals while reinforcing the institute's commitment to public health awareness and community service.

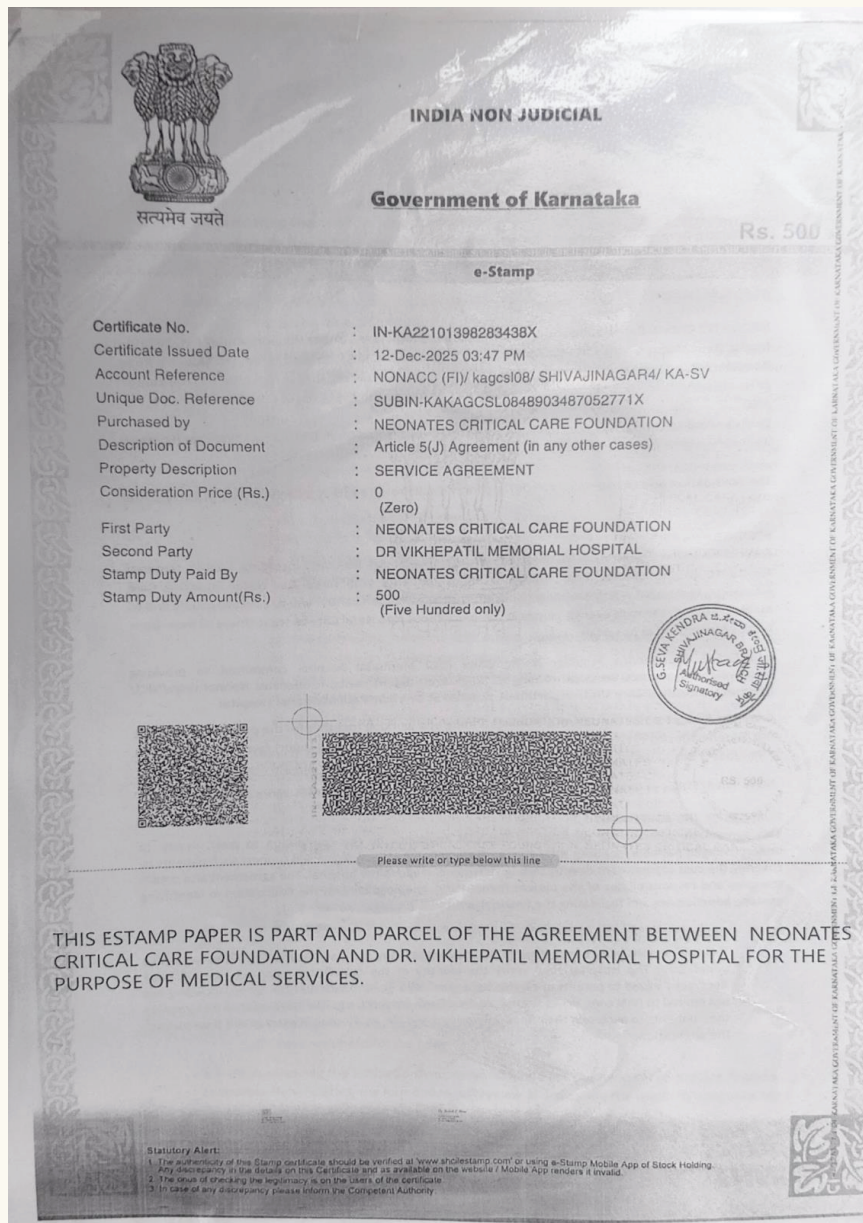
