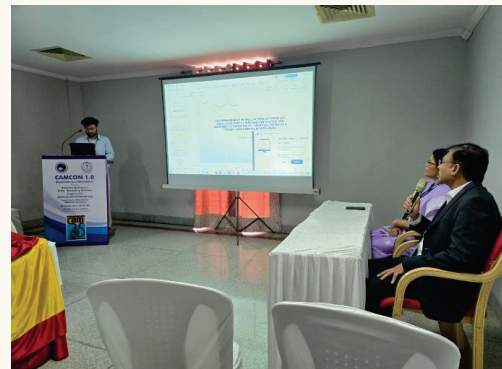
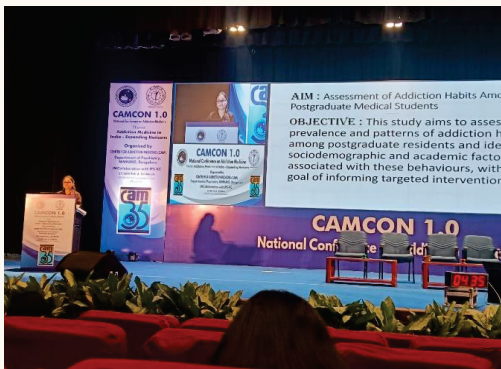

**Title of Activity : Orientation Programme for Postgraduate Students (A.Y 2025-26)**

The Orientation Programme for Postgraduate Students (A.Y 2025-26) was successfully conducted on 4th and 5th March 2026 at Dr. Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation's Medical College, Ahilyanagar. The programme commenced with a welcome address and institutional overview delivered by Prof. Dr. Sunil Natha Mhaske (Dean, Medical College). This was followed by an insightful address by Brig. Dr. Arun Tyagi (Director, Clinical Services), who emphasized the vital role of resident doctors in ensuring the smooth and efficient functioning of the hospital. Prof. Dr. Satish More (Medical Superintendent), elaborated on the routine operations of the hospital and its various clinical departments, providing students with a comprehensive understanding of institutional workflow.

The academic sessions continued with Dr. Shraddha Gunjal (Associate Professor, Dept. of Microbiology), who highlighted research methodology and institutional ethical processes. In the afternoon, Dr. Soumya Ponnann (IQAC Coordinator & Assistant Professor, Dept. of PSM) addressed the code of conduct and internal quality assurance systems. 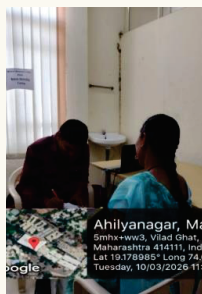


**Title of Activity : International Women’s Day**

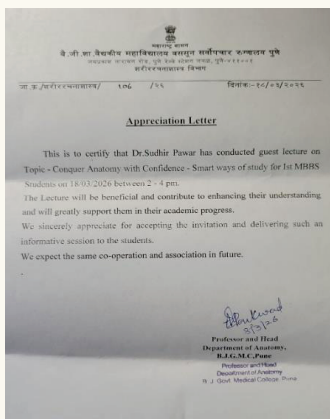
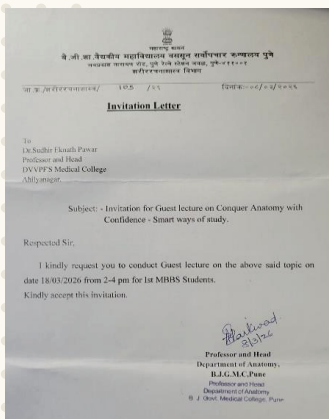


**Title of Activity : Insightful Guest Lecture on Smart Study Strategies for MBBS Students**

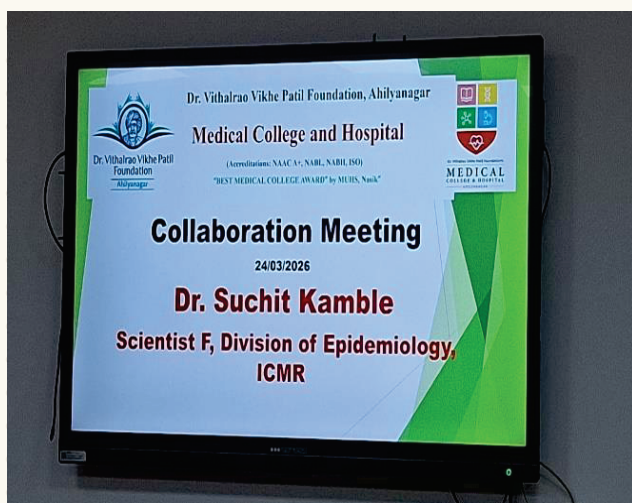
## EVENT - 11

**Organizer : Dept. of Community Medicine and General Medicine, DVVPF Medical College and Hospital, Ahilyanagar**


