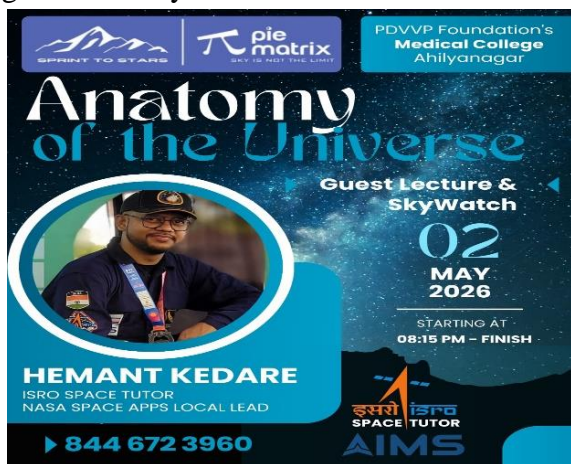
**Title : Stargazing & Guest Lecture – "Anatomy of the Universe"**

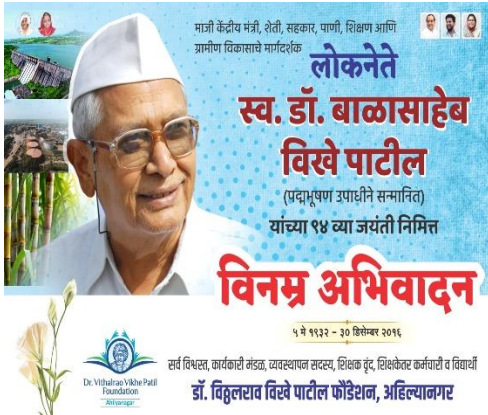

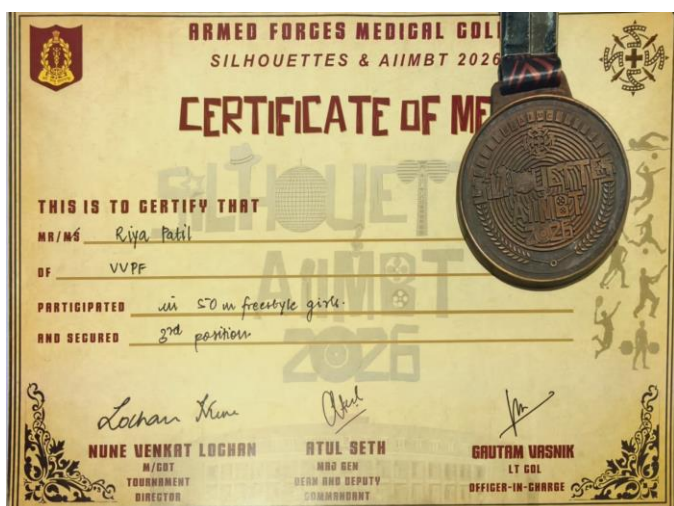
**Title : Participation and Achievements at AFMC Pune Sports Competition 2026**

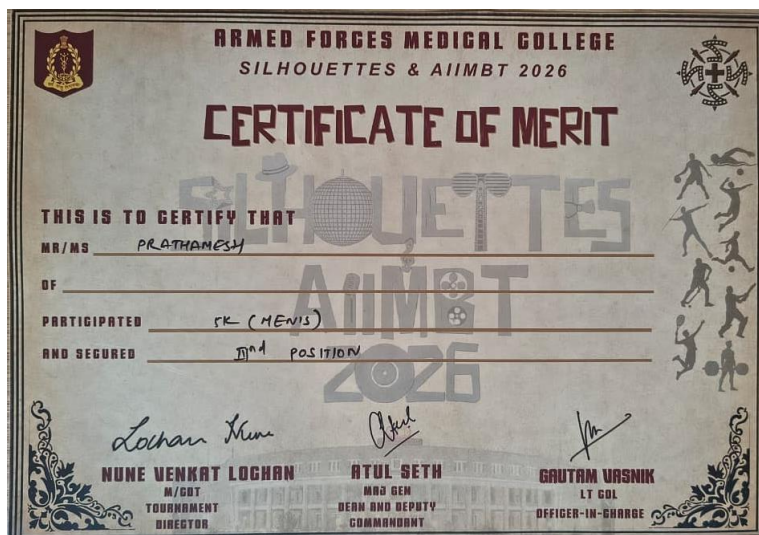
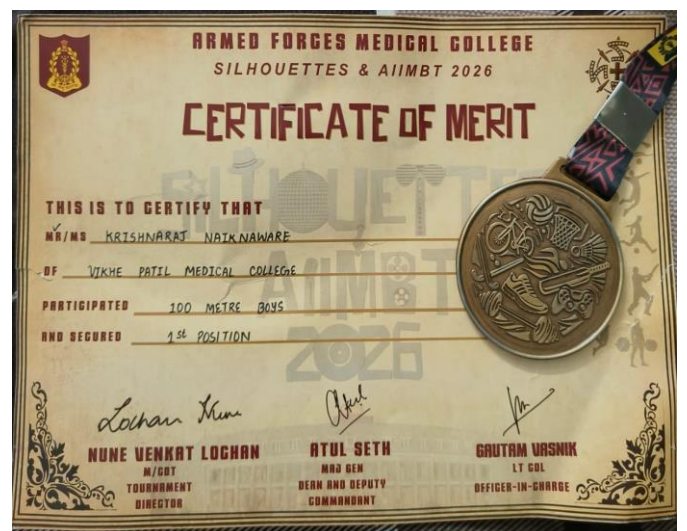
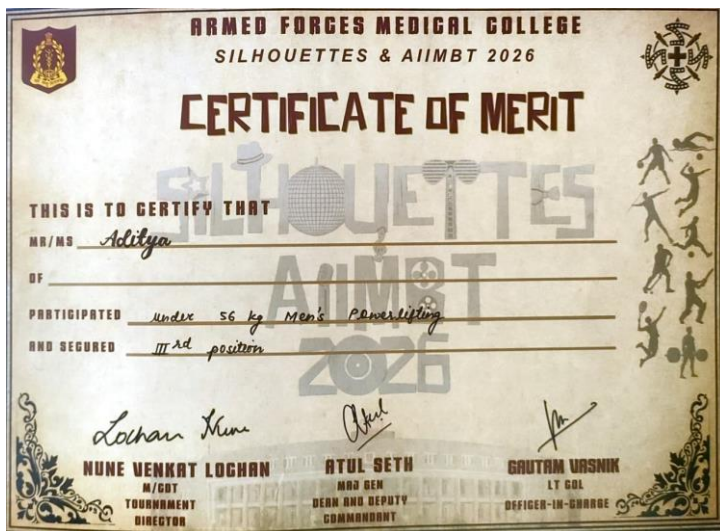
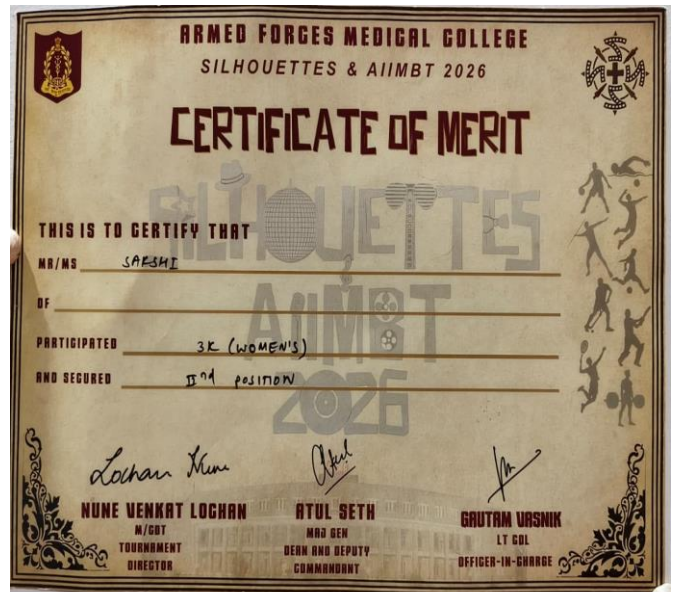

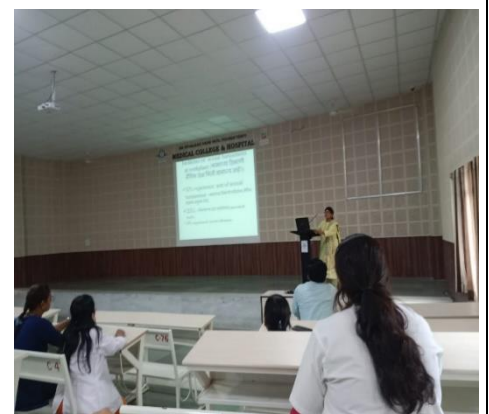
**Title : POSH Awareness and Training Session for Resident Doctors**

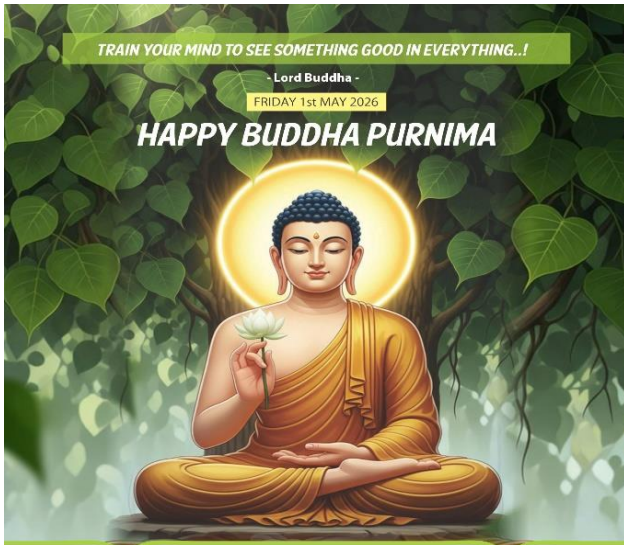
**Title : Achievement of Dr. Abhijit Shinde in Advanced Nutrition Care**
