STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE OF THE DEPARTMENT

A) Academic

a) Theory classes

Theory classes are conducted for 1st year, & IV semester & VIth & VII sem.

- i) Planning for specific learning objectives of particular topic.
- ii) Deciding appropriate method of teaching & learning
- iii) Preparing the lecture in concise manner pertaining to S.L.O.S.
- iv) Delivery of the lecture.
- v) Interactive session
- vi) Feedback of the topic.
- vii) Taking attendance of students
- viii) Maintaining record of attendance.

B) Standard Operating Procedure for Practical

Practical sessions are conducted in IIIrd & IVth semester. For Environment, Nutrition & Biostatistics in 2 batches.

1. Preparing specific learning objectives of the topic.
2. Deciding appropriate method of teaching.
3. Arrangement of specimens/models/slides in the Laboratory
4. Briefing /Instructions for the students in Demo Hall.
5. Small groups of students are allowed to enter in the Laboratory turn by turn.
6. Demonstrations regarding models/slides.
7. Interactive session for entire batch.
8. Feedback
9. Attendance of the students.

Standard Operating Procedure for Field Visits/Postings

Field visit are conducted for IIIrd & IV semester students for 3 batches (50 students)

- i) Planning for the field visit dates & time.
- ii) Taking permission from the appropriate authorities where visit is planned prior to the visit
- iii) Sending requisition for arrangement of vehicle for transport
- iv) Briefing about the purpose of the visit by tutors in 9 to 10 am.
- v) Instruct students about maintaining discipline while transport & at the field
- vi) Visit to actual field place
- vii) Briefing by the concerned person (from NGO/PHC etc)
- viii) Feedback
- ix) Attendance

Standard Operating Procedure for Infrastructure Maintenance

1. All demo rooms are cleaned every day before and after the classes commence.
2. The class rooms are well ventilated and lighting facilities are regularly inspected by demo room in charge.
3. Demo room in charge (Non – Teaching Staff) will check the availability of demo rooms for the lectures and practical's during the preparation of weekly departmental time table for the MBBS, BPTH & NURSING students.
4. Demo rooms are LCD projectors and Wi- Fi facility are used to aid and improve the teaching learning process in all the classrooms and in charge will regularly inspect and assured its proper functioning.
5. Engineer from maintenance department for maintenance of LCD projectors and Wi- Fi facilities in demo rooms (call on-234).

Standard Operating Procedure for UHTC and RHTC

Role and Responsibilities of health centers-These are under the administrative control of Dean of the Medical College.

1. Unit Head will be overall in charge of the UHTC/ RHTC on the behalf of Head of Community Medicine department and other unit members will assist him/her.
2. Will be supervising the overall funding of the UHTC/ RHTC under the guideline of Head of the department.
3. Will coordinate UG/ PG teaching, training and examination activities between the field staff & in charge of concerned divisions of the department.
4. Will support and monitor the services being delivered at UHTC/ RHTC on behalf of the Head of the department.
5. Will coordinate with local urban/Rural health team on the behalf of Head of department.
6. Will coordinate with concerned in charge of health education / research /Projects for field activities at UHTC/RHTC area.
7. Training and technical support to the frontline health professional.
8. Any activity deemed to be in the capacity and assigned by the Head of department

SOPs

1.Daily OPD

- Registration of the patient at registration counter.
- OPD paper is issued.
- Patient will wait in waiting room till his turn.
- Medical officer examines the patient and advice investigations and treatment.
- OPD Nurse will guide the patient to laboratory/Dressing room/injection room as required
- Admission of the patient or referral if required.
- If referral to the Vikhe Patil hospital, transport vehicle available at health center is

used.

2. Specialty Services-

- **ANC OPD** –Once a Week. Faculty from OBGY Dept. of Vikhe Patil Hospital visits UHTC/RHTC on particular day and time
- ANC checkup / investigations and treatment /TT immunization are the services offered.
- Family planning advice and contraceptives provided to eligible couples
- **Pediatric OPD**- Once a Week. Faculty from Pediatrics Dept. of Vikhe Patil hospital visits UHTC/RHTC on particular day and time
- Examination, treatment and immunization are the services offered
- **Daily Ward round in RHTC**-Morning and evening rounds by interns and medical officer. Monitoring and review of conditions of patients in ward is carried out.

3. Health education-impacted in seminar room

4. Training of Interns and undergraduate students-. Carrying out various activities School Health Program, family surveys, Conducting field survey, health environment study, family studies, case study and mini projects to understand the field epidemiology including physical and social environment of the urban and rural areas.

5. Community health assessment- Family Visits twice a week by the interns/students and nurses. Records are maintained in family folders

6. Records at health centers- Health Management Information System (HMIS): Under primary health care/health programs various registers (OPD/IPD/Immunization/Family planning) record and reports are prescribed. These are to be filled up from frontline health workers to Medical Officer.

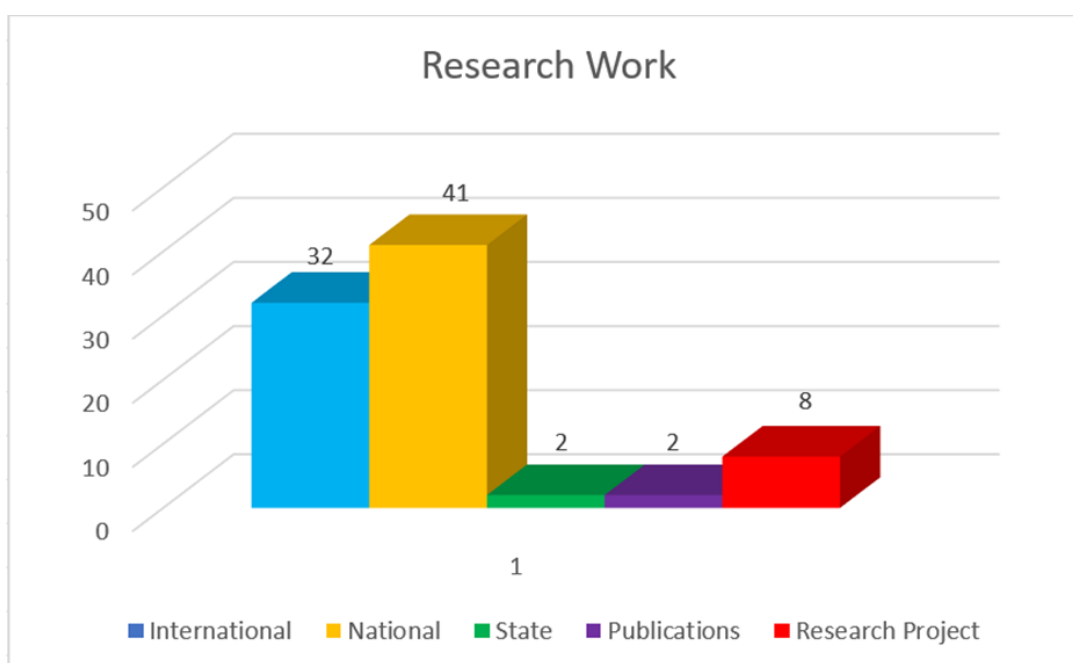

FUTURISTIC PLAN

General

Aim

The aim is to consolidate the strengths of the department and improve the infrastructure and basic necessities to provide quality medical education to Undergraduate students and train them to work as Family physicians to provide comprehensive primary health care.

INFRASTRUCTURE

RHTC

This center is the fundamental and inescapable requirement of the department of community medicine, as it is the launch pad for all community based programmes of public health and an important training tool for the undergraduates, interns, residents of clinical department, nursing students.

Recently our institute received permission to develop Rural Hospital, Wambori to develop as Rural Health Training Center. Accordingly training facilities for interns, residents residential facilities for interns will be developed in Wambori. Community services will be extended and specialty services like medicine, surgery, pediatrics, ophthalmology will be provided by posting the faculties and residents from our institute. Besides the infrastructure / equipment/instruments, necessary manpower needs to be provided.

UHTC

UHTC to provide comprehensive health services has been developed and is functioning at new location since July 2021 with infrastructure facilities to provide out patient services, general as well as specialty services, essential laboratory services. All the families in urban

slums and other families in the field practice area of UHTC will be enrolled and family folders will be prepared.

Extension of services to provide preventive /curative services, speciality services in Medicine, surgery, ortho, ophthalmology ,gynaec, pediatrics, etc. will be provided by posting the faculties and residents from our institute.

Library

Recent editions all textbooks in Preventive and Social Medicine and Public Health ,Health Administration and Management, WHO modules, training modules National as well as international journals will be made available for Students as well as faculties

Museum

The status and standard of the department of Community Medicine can be gauged by the museum of the department. Health Education & Prevention, WHO criteria and National programmes need to be highlighted especially for UGs in the museum. New models, equipments, charts will be available as per the new NMC guidelines,

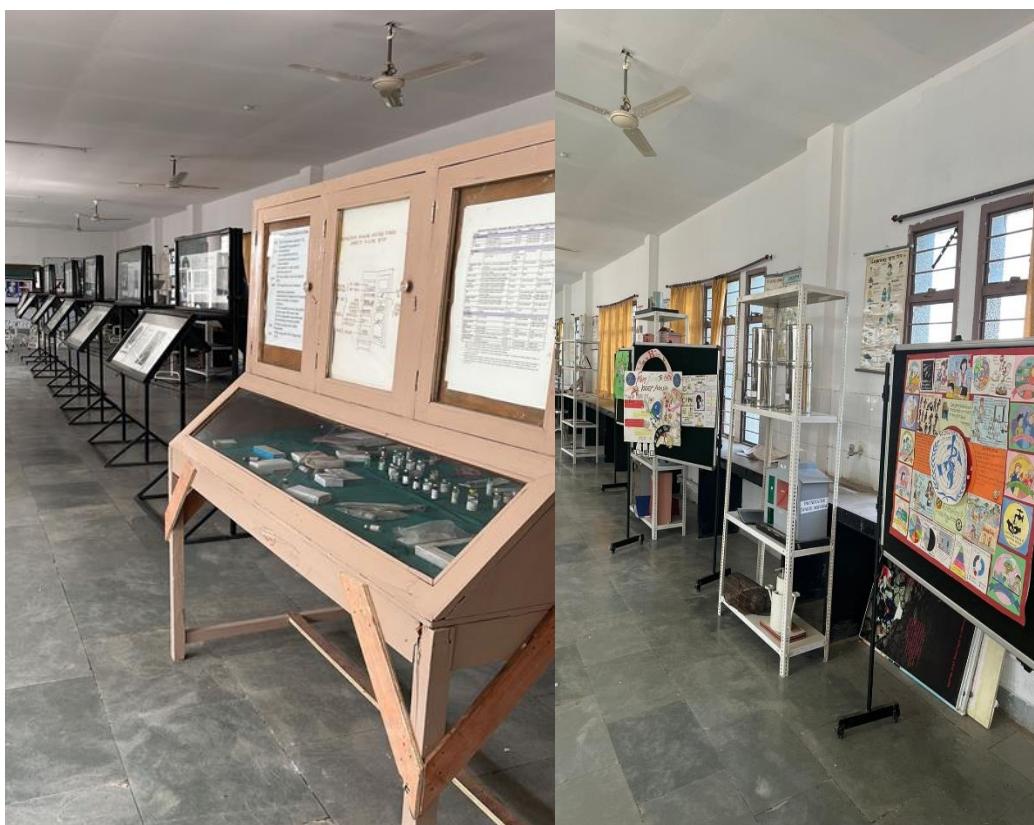
